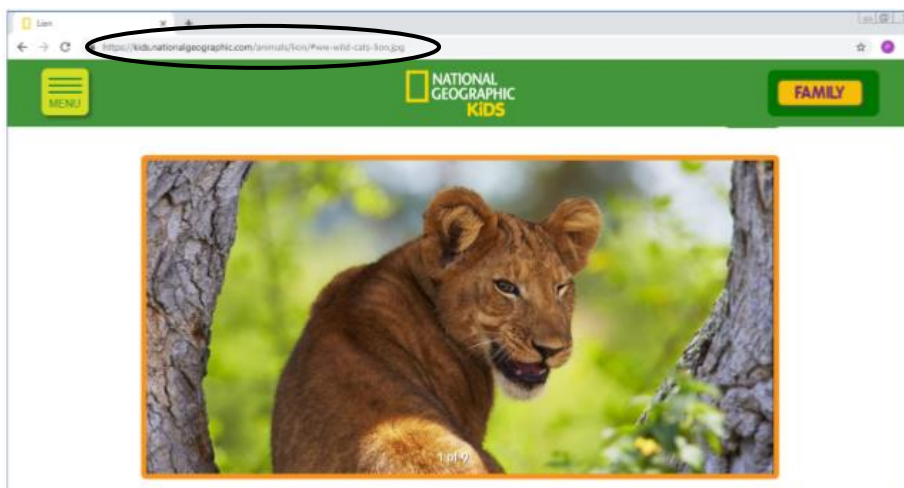
Q.1. Fill in the blanks.

- b. Write the steps to save the address of the web page.

Ans: You can perform the following steps to save the address of a web page in Google Chrome:

- **Step 1:** Click on the 'three dots' option at the right-hand side corner of the browser and select the 'Bookmarks' option.
- **Step 2:** Select the 'Bookmark this page' option.
- **Step 3:** A box will appear. Click on the 'Done' button to add the address of the current web page to the list of bookmarks.

You can open a bookmarked web page by selecting it from the list of bookmarks.
